High-Voltage Electrode Warning Covers

Q: What languages are used for the warnings?

A: Every warning cover provided by AGI displays the warning “Danger High Voltage” in English, Spanish, and Chinese. Additionally, there is a large graphic displaying an ISO lightning bolt on both sides of the cover.

Q: Are these included when I buy a system or system package?

A: No.

Q: Am I required to purchase warning covers?

A: It is recommended to use warning covers or warning signage. The high-visibility, bright yellow covers alert a passerby that there is dangerous voltage nearby. They also provide a visible warning that protect buried electrode stakes from being tripped over, trampled on, or removed. Many international companies have security standards that require safety signage.


Q: Where do I place the warning covers?

A: After you’ve attached the Take-Out Electrode to the stainless steel stake, cover both with the warning cover.
